
## 2. Android Device

Tap the Xfleet application icon  to bring up the login page.

### 2.1 Login

#### 2.1.1 Login to the Xfleet server

1. To log in the EverFocus Xfleet, enter the user name, password and the IP address of the Xfleet server.
2. Tap the Login button to log in.





### 2.1.2 Access the MDVRs

1. To search the MDVRs connected to the same network of your handheld device, tap the Find button.




2. The search result will be displayed on the screen. Tap a desired MDVR to bring up the MDVR live view.




## 2.2 Operation Guide


### 2.2.1 Map

You can monitor vehicle locations on the Map page.


1. Tap the **Map** tab  to enter the Map page.
2. Tap the Search  button to bring up the vehicle list as below.



Select a desired vehicle and its location will be displayed on the map.



- 3. Up to 64 vehicle locations can be displayed on the map simultaneously (the displayed number of vehicles can be adjusted on the Setting page, see 2.2.5 Setting).




- 4. You can tap the  button to move to the previous / next vehicle.


### 2.2.2 Video

You can monitor video streams from MDVRs on the Video page.


1. Tap the **Video** tab  to enter the Video page.
2. Tap the Search  button to bring up the vehicle list as below.



Select a desired vehicle and its video streams from MDVRs will be displayed on the screen.



- If there are more than 4 channels of MDVRs, you can swipe left or right and click the **Play** button to view more channels.





- You can tap the buttons on the tool bar to operate the following functions:

-  Click to bring up the PTZ menu.
-  Click to start / stop recording the current video streams. The system will generate a separate video file for each channel.
-  Click to stop playing the video streams.
-  Click to start playing the video streams.
-  Click to take a snapshot of the current video streams. The system will generate a separate image file for each channel.
-  Click to transfer the sound from the MDVR to the handheld device.
-  Click to transfer the sound from the handheld device to the MDVR.


### 2.2.3 Track

You can monitor vehicle GPS tracks on the Track page.

1. Tap the **Track** tab  to enter the Track page.
2. Tap the Search  button to bring up the vehicle list as below.



3. Select a desired vehicle and its GPS track will be displayed on the map.



4. You can tap the  button to pause / stop playing the GPS track, or tap the  button to start playing the GPS track.


### 2.2.4 Playback

You can play back the recordings from MDVRs on the Playback page.

1. Tap the **Playback** tab  to enter the Playback page.
2. Tap the Search  button to bring up the Search Record page as below.



3. Enter the search conditions and tap the Search button, the recording files of selected vehicle will be displayed on the screen.




4. Select a desired recording file to play back. You can only play 1 channel at a time.


### 2.2.5 Setting

You can configure the system settings on the Setting page.

1. Tap the **Setting** tab  to enter the Setting page.



2. To change the map displayed on the Map page, tap **Map** to bring up the Map menu as below. After you select a map, you need to re-login to apply the setting.



3. To adjust the number of vehicles displayed on the Map page, tap **Map shows** to bring up the Map shows menu as below.



- To display / hide vehicle location under vehicle name on the vehicle list, enable / disable the **Location** option.
